
CONNECTING THE KORG PA SERIES TO AN EXTERNAL SEQUENCER (MIDIWORKS)

You can program a new Song on an external sequencer, using Korg PA as a multi-timbral expander.

Connections and settings via MIDI Interface

In order to connect the Korg PA to a computer, you need to have a computer with the MIDI interface.

1. Connect the Pa80 and the computer as in the following diagram.




2. Go to "MIDI Setup" . Select the External Sequencer Setup.

	Setup.

Connections and settings via USB to Host

- 1. In case you will connect the computer and the Pa800 via the USB port, install the Korg USB MIDI Driver, as explained in the User's Manual of your instrument.
- 2. Connect the Pa800 and the computer either via the USB Device port, or via the MIDI ports and a MIDI interface, as shown in the following diagram.



5. Go to "MIDI Setup". Select the External Sequencer Setup.
